


- 4. Redraw the stick figure diagram that demonstrates light placement for flat lighting.




- 5. What are the characteristics of BUTTERFLY lighting on a subject's face?
- 6. Redraw the stick figure diagram that demonstrates light placement for BUTTERFLY lighting.




7. What are the characteristics of LOOP lighting on a subject's face?




9. What is the purpose of a fill light when combined with a key light?
